- spontaneous fermentation
- aging in traditional oval-shaped oak or chestnut barrels ranging from 600 to 2400 liters
- up to eight months on the lees
- filtration before bottling

Bottled with 12.5% alcohol, the 2018 Weisser Burgunder Kabinett trocken is intense, pure and fresh as well as aromatic on the elegant and substantial yet seductive nose where honeydew melon aromas intermix with limestone and almond or nutty notes. Rich and round on the palate, with notes of gray bread, this is an intense and elegant Pinot Blanc with almost sweetish fruit on the finish. This is a very elegant and mouth-filling Pinot for earlier consumption. It has a well-structured, substantial finish with fine phenolic grip and salinity and ripe apple notes. Tasted from AP 1319 in July 2020.
